## EXPERIENCE?

If you haven't had any diving experience, think of it this way. Neither has any other diver when he or she first starts off....so the sooner you start the sooner you will become happy and familiar with the underwater environment. LUSAC now gives you the opportunity to be taught diving by skilled, qualified (F.A.U.I.) instructors, so that you learn safety, skill and confidence when you begin diving. The course for 1975 is expected to be fully enrolled, so if you want to learn how to explore the wonderful world under the sea, ACT NOW. The LUSAC course is the best available, and for Sports Union members, the least expensive. We charge \$10 per student, compared to \$50 for a commercial course.

So go to the Sports Union for details, AND come to the club meetings in the Union Building every second Friday, commencing the first Friday of term 1, 1975. Bring your friends too.

## TOO MUCH WORK!

The majority of the club members are undergrad students, and so they know what your work load means, and how much spare time you have, and therefore the best times for you to go diving. The rest of the club are postgraduates and members of staff (Psychology, Economics, Chemistry etc) and they even have less time than you. So don't worry too much about how you're going to fit diving into your agenda.....as we all have the same problem.

## EQUIPMENT-

L.U.S.A.C. has air tanks, regulators, safety jackets, wet suits, Stoves, tents.....etc, etc, all for the use members. We even have a few basic items such as masks, fins etc. But be prepared to spend \$10 - \$15 for your own basic gear - mask, fins, snorkel first of all.

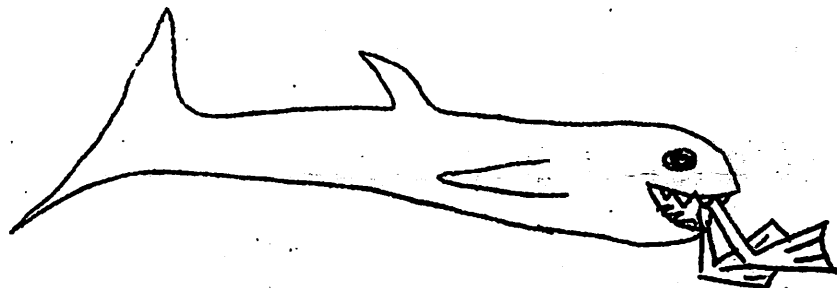
## AIR

## MEETINGS

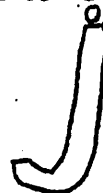
